CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Designer Note: Take care when cutting the 5½" x 9½" directional print rectangles (Fabrics B, C, D, E, F, and H) to maintain print orientation. Print direction is not taken in account when cutting fabrics for Flying Geese units. Cut in order as given, as some subcuts are from previously cut strips.

WOF = width of fabric (from selvage to selvage)

Fabric A [26711 N] (Geese Vignette Patches, Navy), cut:

- (7) 5½" x WOF strips. Piece strips together and subcut (4) 5½" x 66" strips (outer border).
- (2) 84" x WOF strips (backing).

Fabric B [26712 A] (Geese Lake Scenic, Tan), cut:

- (1) 5½" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 9½" horizontal x 5½" vertical rectangles (block B1).
- (1) 9½" x WOF strip. Subcut (5) 5½" horizontal x 9½" vertical rectangles (blocks B2 and B3).

Fabric C [26712 W] (Geese Lake Scenic, Chambray), cut:

- (1) 5½" x WOF strip. Subcut (3) 9½" horizontal x 5½" vertical rectangles (blocks C2 and C4).
- (1) 9½" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5½" horizontal x 9½" vertical rectangles (blocks C1 and C3).
- From remaining fabric, cut (4) 2" x 3½" rectangles (flying geese units).

Fabric D [26713 E] (Baby Geese, Cream), cut:

- (1) 9½" x WOF strip. Subcut (1) 5½" horizontal x 9½" vertical rectangle (block D2).
- From remaining fabric, subcut (3) 9½" horizontal x 5½" vertical rectangles (blocks D1 and D3).

Fabric E [26713 G] (Baby Geese, Green), cut:

- (2) 3½" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2" x 3½" rectangles (flying geese units).
- (1) 9½" x WOF strip. Subcut (1) 5½" horizontal x 9½" vertical rectangle (block E2).
- From remaining 9½" strip, subcut (2) 9½" horizontal x 5½" vertical rectangles (block E1).

Fabric F [26713 W] (Baby Geese, Denim), cut:

- (2) 3½" x WOF strips. Subcut (22) 2" x 3½" rectangles (flying geese units).
- (1) 9½" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5½" horizontal x 9½" vertical rectangles (block F2).
- From remaining 9½" strip, subcut (1) 9½" horizontal x 5½" vertical rectangle (block F1).

Fabric G [26714 A] (Feathers, Dk Tan), cut:

- (2) 3½" x WOF strips. Subcut (26) 2" x 3½" rectangles (flying geese units).

Fabric H [26714 T] (Feathers, Rust), cut:

- (1) 3½" x WOF strip. Subcut (18) 2" x 3½" rectangles (flying geese units).
- (1) 5½" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 9½" horizontal x 5½" vertical rectangles (blocks H1 and H2).

Fabric I [26714 W] (Feathers, Navy), cut:

- (1) 3½" x WOF strip. Subcut (20) 2" x 3½" rectangles (flying geese units).
- (1) 1½" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 1½" x 1½" squares (row sashing cornerstones).
- (8) 2¼" x WOF strips (binding).

Fabric J [23528 EZ] (Color Blends, Oatmeal), cut:

- (8) 1½" x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 1½" x 9½" rectangles (all blocks).
- (13) 1½" x WOF strips. From seven strips, subcut (27) 1½" x 9½" rectangles (block and row sashing). From three strips, subcut (6) 1½" x 19½" rectangles (row sashing). Piece remaining three 1½" strips together; subcut (2) 1½" x 49½" strips (row sashing).
- (18) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (360) 2" x 2" squares (flying geese units).
- (6) 2½" x WOF strips. Piece strips together; subcut (2) 2½" x 53½" strips (inner border 1; top/bottom) and (2) 2½" x 59½" strips (inner border 1; sides).

Fabric K [23528 FQ] (Color Blends, Fir), cut:

- (1) 3½" x WOF strip. Subcut (20) 2" x 3½" rectangles (flying geese units).

Fabric L [24776 H] (Harmony Woven, Frosted Pine), cut:

- (2) 3½" x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 2" x 3½" rectangles (flying geese units).
- (6) 1¾" x WOF strips. Piece strips together and subcut (2) 1¾" x 56" strips (inner border 2; top/bottom) and (2) 1¾" x 63½" strips (inner border 2; sides).

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout unless otherwise indicated.

Flying Geese Units

1. Select all (360) Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) 2" squares and all (180) Fabric C, E, F, G, H, I, K, and L 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all (360) Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) 2" squares.

3. Place a marked Fabric J 2" square on a 2" x 3 1/2" rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the drawn line as shown. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line and press the triangle toward the corner. Repeat on the opposite end of the rectangle to complete a Flying Geese (FG) Unit. Make 180 FG Units.



Block FG1 Assembly

1. Lay out one each Fabric K, I, F, E, G, and L 2" x 3 1/2" FG units as shown. Join six units together to make one FG1 block. Make and label twelve FG1 blocks.



Block FG2 Assembly

1. Lay out one each Fabric H, F, E, G, L, and E 2" x 3 1/2" FG units as shown. Join six units together to make one FG2 block. Make and label ten FG2 blocks.



Block FG3 Assembly

1. Lay out one each Fabric L, G, E, I, H, and K 2" x 3 1/2" FG units as shown. Join six units together to make one FG3 block. Make and label four FG3 blocks.



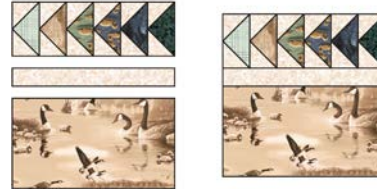
Block FG4 Assembly

1. Lay out one each Fabric L, C, E, I, H, and K 2" x 3 1/2" FG units as shown. Join six units together to make one FG4 block. Make and label four FG4 blocks.



Block B1 Assembly (make 2)

1. Lay out one FG1 block, one 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and 9 1/2" (horizontal) x 5 1/2" (vertical) Fabric B (Geese Lake Scenic, Tan) rectangle as shown. Join the pieces to make one B1 block. Make and label two B1 blocks.



Block B2 Assembly (make 3)

1. Lay out one 5 1/2" (horizontal) x 9 1/2" (vertical) Fabric B (Geese Lake Scenic, Tan) rectangle, one 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one FG1 block as shown. Join the pieces to make one B2 block. Make and label three B2 blocks.



Block B3 Assembly (make 2)

1. Lay out one FG1 block, one 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one 5 1/2" (horizontal) x 9 1/2" (vertical) Fabric B (Geese Lake Scenic, Tan) rectangle as shown. Join the pieces to make one B3 block. Make and label two B3 blocks.



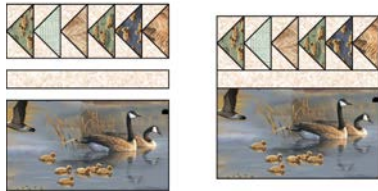
Block C1 Assembly (make 3)

1. Lay out one 5 1/2" (horizontal) x 9 1/2" (vertical) Fabric C (Geese Lake Scenic, Chambray) rectangle, one 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one FG2 block as shown. Join the pieces to make one C1 block. Make and label three C1 blocks.



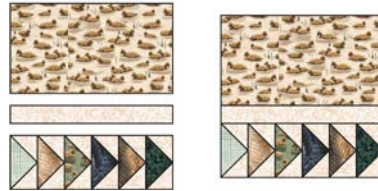
Block C2 Assembly (make 2)

1. Lay out one FG2 block, one 1½" x 9½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one 9½" (horizontal) x 5½" (vertical) Fabric C (Geese Lake Scenic, Chambray) rectangle as shown. Join the pieces to make one C2 block. Make and label two C2 blocks.



Block D1 Assembly (make 2)

1. Lay out one 9½" (horizontal) x 5½" (vertical) Fabric D (Baby Geese, Cream) rectangle, one 1½" x 9½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one FG3 block as shown. Join the pieces to make one D1 block. Make and label two D1 blocks.



Block C3 Assembly (make 1)

1. Lay out one FG2 block, one 1½" x 9½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one 5½" (horizontal) x 9½" (vertical) Fabric C (Geese Lake Scenic, Chambray) rectangle as shown. Join the pieces to make one C3 block. Make and label one C3 block.



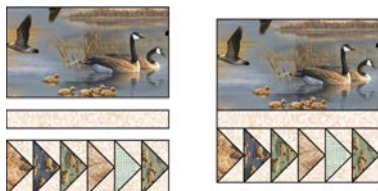
Block D2 Assembly (make 1)

1. Lay out one 5½" (horizontal) x 9½" (vertical) Fabric D (Baby Geese, Cream) rectangle, one 1½" x 9½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one FG3 block as shown. Join the pieces to make one D2 block. Make and label one D2 block.



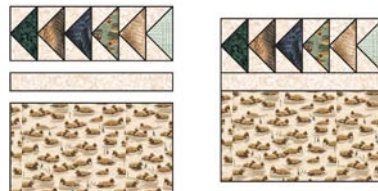
Block C4 Assembly (make 1)

1. Lay out one 9½" (horizontal) x 5½" (vertical) Fabric C (Geese Lake Scenic, Chambray) rectangle, one 1½" x 9½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one FG2 block as shown. Join the pieces to make one C4 block. Make and label one C4 block.



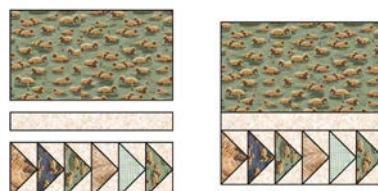
Block D3 Assembly (make 1)

1. Lay out one FG3 block, one 1½" x 9½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one 9½" (horizontal) x 5½" (vertical) Fabric D (Baby Geese, Cream) rectangle as shown. Join the pieces to make one D3 block. Make and label one D3 block.



Block E1 Assembly (make 2)

1. Lay out one 9½" (horizontal) x 5½" (vertical) Fabric E (Baby Geese, Green) rectangle, one 1½" x 9½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one FG2 block as shown. Join the pieces to make one E1 block. Make and label two E1 blocks.



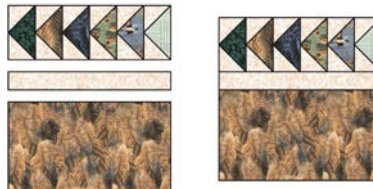
Block E2 Assembly (make 1)

1. Lay out one FG2 block, one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (horizontal) x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " (vertical) Fabric E (Baby Geese, Green) rectangle, as shown. Join the pieces to make one E2 block. Make and label one E2 block.



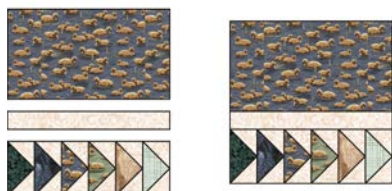
Block H2 Assembly (make 2)

1. Lay out one FG4 block, one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one $9\frac{1}{2}$ " (horizontal) x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (vertical) Fabric H (Feathers, Rust) rectangle as shown. Join the pieces to make one H2 block. Make and label two H2 blocks.



Block F1 Assembly (make 1)

1. Lay out one $9\frac{1}{2}$ " (horizontal) x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (vertical) Fabric F (Baby Geese, Denim) rectangle, one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one FG1 block as shown. Join the pieces to make one F1 block. Make and label one F1 block.



Quilt Center Row Assembly

Refer to the *Quilt Assembly diagram on page 7 for the following steps, noting the orientation of each block in the row. All rows should measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $49\frac{1}{2}$ " when complete.*

1. Row 1. Sew five $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks (Blocks F1, C1, H1, B2, D1) and four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangles together for Row 1.

2. Row 2. Sew five $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks (Blocks B3, D3, F2, C2, B3) and four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangles together for Row 2.

3. Row 3. Sew five $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks (Blocks C1, E1, B2, D1, C1) and four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangles together for Row 2.

4. Row 4. Sew five $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks (Blocks B1, F2, C2, F2, H2) and four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangles together for Row 4.

5. Row 5. Sew five $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks (Blocks H1, D2, E1, B2, C4) and four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangles together for Row 5.

6. Row 6. Sew five $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks (Blocks C3, B1, F2, H2, E2) and four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangles together for Row 6.

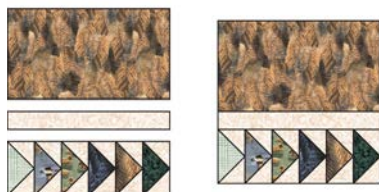
Block F2 Assembly (make 4)

1. Lay out one FG1 block, one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (horizontal) x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " (vertical) Fabric F (Baby Geese, Denim) rectangle, as shown. Join the pieces to make one F2 block. Make and label four F2 blocks.



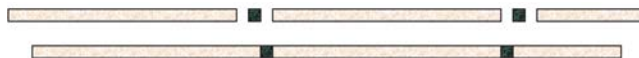
Block H1 Assembly (make 2)

1. Lay out one $9\frac{1}{2}$ " (horizontal) x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (vertical) Fabric H (Feathers, Rust) rectangle, one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle, and one FG4 block as shown. Join the pieces to make one H1 block. Make and label two H1 blocks.



Pieced Sashing Row Assembly (make 3)

1. Join together two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $19\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangles, two Fabric I (Feathers, Navy) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square cornerstones, and one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) rectangle as shown for Pieced Sashing (PS) Row. Make three PS Rows.



Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the *Quilt Assembly Diagram* below. Note orientation of the pieced sashing rows when joining quilt center rows together.

1. Sew pieces together in the following order: Block Row 1, PS Row, Block Row 2, 1½" x 49½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) strip, Block Row 3, PS Row, Block Row 4, 1½" x 49½" Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) strip, Block Row 5, PS Row, Block Row 6. Quilt Center should measure 49½" x 59½".

Quilt Top Assembly

1. *Inner Border #1.* Sew the Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) side borders to the quilt center. Sew the Fabric J (Color Blends, Oatmeal) top/bottom borders to the quilt center.
2. *Inner Border #2.* Sew the Fabric L (Harmony Woven, Frosted Pine) side borders to the quilt center. Sew the Fabric L (Harmony Woven, Frosted Pine) top/bottom borders to the quilt center.
3. *Outer Border.* Noting orientation, sew the Fabric A (Geese Vignette Patches, Navy) side borders to the

quilt center. Sew the Fabric A (Geese Vignette Patches, Navy) top/bottom borders to the quilt center. Quilt top is complete and should measure 66" x 76".

Finishing the Quilt

1. If not already done, cut (the backing) Fabric A (Geese Vignette Patches, Navy) into two 84" lengths. Sew the pieces together lengthwise. Press the seam allowance toward one side.
2. Layer the backing (seam placed vertically), batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the quilt top.
3. Using the 2¼"-wide Fabric I (Feathers, Navy) strips, make double-fold binding and attach it to the quilt.
